1. Please provide additional details on the risers – Images are attached – photograph of existing risers and drawings attached again.
2. color swatch, or link to color for reference –Since these are glass 4 sides it is really the bottom that is covered. Base should match risers. Bottom needs a deck at base height. Preferably removable. Photo of riser from question 1 serves for color reference – discontinued Knoll Bisque fabric swatch available upon request – for color and texture matching. 3. do these require a certain weight capacity? weight capacity is 200 lbs with 20 lbs per shelf. 4. Can these be open on the bottom? Risers - are used all sides. Cases - Bottom needs a deck at base height. Preferably removable.
5. We cannot offer tempered glass due to safety concerns. Is laminated glass acceptable? – yes.
6. Is museum grade acrylic acceptable as an alternative to glass? - no
7. Do the cases require UV filtering glass? No
8. Do the cases require silica/ humidity control chambers? If so, outside access to these chambers? no – humidity control chambers not necessary
9. Should the finish be powder coated? Is there a specific RAL color? – If metal framing, then yes powder coated - Black RAL 9005 Jet black or RAL 9011 Graphite black
10. Required base height of the cases? Base height range 6-10”
11. Are shelves required in the cases? If so, how many? – yes, 4 adjustable height shelves.
12. Address for delivery including details regarding receiving area and if there are delivery restrictions – Cape Fear Museum of History and Science, 814 Market Street, Wilmington, NC 28401. Covered loading dock available – 12’ height limit.
13. Are there pictures available that you can forward of the cubes, wedges, & risers—See Attachment (Case Image with Cylinder Risers)
14. Do the cylinders need tops and bottoms? Risers need all sides to be covered with linen-not open at base.
15. What is the preferred material for construction of these items?  
Preferred materials for construction would be archival friendly materials –  
0% Formaldehyde MDF panel product  
Coated with 3 coats polyurethane or enamel  
Glue - Hide glue for mounting fabric to substrates (non-off gassing adhesive)
